The plant is situated in the Postmasburg area, approximately 80 km south of the Sishen main plant in the Northern Cape Province.

The SENET scope of work consisted of the design, supply, fabrication, erection and commissioning of nine new in-plant belt conveyors (complete with transfer stations, tramp iron removal, sampling stations for material quality control, moisture and particle analysers) to handle the run-of-mine iron ore from the offloading pit area, storage area and feed to the export load-out station, as well as three-yard conveyors that interface with the stacker and reclaimer machines supplied by others.
